

Call for Nominations

The Ohio Academy of History Public History Award 2010

The Ohio Academy of History is now soliciting nominations for the 2010 Public History Award. The purpose of this award is to encourage the dissemination of historical scholarship beyond the walls of academe. To be nominated, a public history project, publication, or program must have been accomplished within the previous two years and completed by January 15 of the award year. All public history fields are included in this awards program including exhibits, publications, audio/visual documentaries, oral history, public programs, symposia, archival projects, and historic preservation education projects. Nominations are encouraged which demonstrate meritorious achievement beyond the routine function of everyday work.

Nominated projects, publications, or programs must:

- Demonstrate original research which adds to a greater understanding of the past.
- Demonstrate creativity in the way the project, program, or publication is organized and presented.
- Demonstrate originality or uniqueness in design and historical interpretation
- Accomplish a goal of educating or communicating with the intended audience
- Follow commonly accepted rules of evidence and logic in providing proof of statements, facts, and conclusions.

Deadline for nominations is December 1, 2009.
